AUSTRALIAN ACTIVE SERVICE MEDAL 1945-1975 REGULATIONS

DECLARATION UNDER REGULATION 3

DETERMINATION UNDER SUBREGULATION 4(2)

I, **WILLIAM PATRICK DEANE**, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 11 December 1997 ("the Regulations"), and on the recommendation of the Minister for Defence Industry, Science and Personnel:

- (a) **declare**, under regulation 3 of the Regulations, the following Defence Force activities to be a prescribed operation:
 - (i) Defence Force activities in Sabah, Sarawak and Brunei during the period that commenced on 24 December 1962 and ended on 11 August 1966;
 - (ii) Defence Force activities in the Malay Peninsula/Singapore during the period that commenced on 17 August 1964 and ended on 11 August 1966; and
- (b) **determine**, under subregulation 4(2) of the Regulations, that the conditions for award of the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'MALAYSIA' in respect of that prescribed operation are:
 - (i) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'BORNEO' in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 2466 dated September 1964;
 - (ii) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'MALAY PENINSULA' in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 3432 dated October 1967; and


- (iii) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, in accordance with a determination made by the Minister under paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, is in a class of persons who may be awarded the Medal with clasp 'MALAYSIA'.

Classes of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'MALAYSIA'

For the purposes of paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, I determine the persons described below to be a class of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'MALAYSIA':

- (a) Australian civilians who qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'BORNEO' in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 2466 dated September 1964; and
- (b) Australian civilians who qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'MALAY PENINSULA' in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 3432 dated October 1967.
