AUSTRALIAN ACTIVE SERVICE MEDAL 1945-75 REGULATIONS

DECLARATION UNDER REGULATION 3

DETERMINATION UNDER SUBREGULATION 4(2)

I, **WILLIAM PATRICK DEANE**, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 11 December 1997 ("the Regulations"), and on the recommendation of the Minister for Defence Industry, Science and Personnel:

- (a) **declare**, under regulation 3 of the Regulations, Defence Force activities in South Vietnam during the period that commenced on 24 December 1962 and ended on 27 January 1973 to be a prescribed operation; and
- (b) **determine**, under subregulation 4(2) of the Regulations, that the conditions for award of the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'VIETNAM' in respect of that prescribed operation are:
 - (i) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'SOUTH VIETNAM' in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in a Royal Warrant dated 8 June 1968;
 - (ii) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the Vietnam Medal in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in a Royal Warrant dated 8 June 1968;
 - (iii) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Regulations and Letters Patent dated 24 February 1993; and


- (iv) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, in accordance with a determination made by the Minister under paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, is in a class of persons who may be awarded the Medal with clasp 'VIETNAM'.



DETERMINATION UNDER PARAGRAPH 4(1)(b)

I, **BRONWYN BISHOP**, Minister for Defence Industry, Science and Personnel, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 11 December 1997 ("the Regulations"), make the following determination.

Interpretation

1. In this determination:

"**designated civilians**" means members of the Australian Merchant Navy; members of an Australian Surgical and Medical Team; Australian War Correspondents; members of the Australian Salvation Army; members of the Australian Red Cross; members of the Australian Young Men's Christian Association and members of the Australian Campaigners for Christ.

Classes of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'VIETNAM'

2. For the purposes of paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, I determine the persons described below to be a class of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'VIETNAM':

- (a) civilians who qualified for the General Service Medal 1962 with clasp 'SOUTH VIETNAM', in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in a Royal Warrant dated 8 June 1968;
- (b) civilians who qualified for the Vietnam Medal, in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in a Royal Warrant dated 8 June 1968; and
- (c) designated civilians who qualified for the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal, in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Regulations and Letters Patent dated 24 February 1993.

1. In this determination:

"designated civilians" means civilian members of the Department of Defence, civilian contractors of the Department of Defence, members of the Australian Merchant Navy; members of an Australian Surgical and Medical Team; Australian War Correspondents; members of the Australian Salvation Army; members of the Australian Red Cross; members of the Australian Young Men's Christian Association and members of the Australian Campaigners for Christ.
