I recommend that you administer the Executive Councillor's Oath to them.

Instruments to give effect to these recommendations are provided at Attachment C, for your signature. A copy of my proposed Ministry List, showing Cabinet membership and other ministerial appointments, is at Attachment D for your information.

I also recommend you re-appoint Senator the Hon Mathias Cormann to the office of Vice-President of the Executive Council.

I have been advised that you have agreed to hold an Executive Council meeting at 9.35am on Wednesday 29 May 2019 at Government House, prior to which I would be sworn to the office of Prime Minister and Minister for the Public Service, and the Hon Michael McCormack MP would be sworn as Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Infrastructure, Transport and Regional Development.

At the Executive Council meeting I will be proposing a number of matters to you relating to the structure and machinery of Government, including renaming five departments of state, a new Administrative Arrangements Order, and the creation of two new Executive Agencies.

I understand that following the Executive Council meeting, the swearing-in ceremony for the remainder of the Ministry will be held at 10.00am.
