On 24 December 1985 a man was behaving aggressively at a hotel in Rundle Street, Adelaide. A woman employee was attempting to evict him when Mr Keig came to her assistance. On the footpath outside the man produced a knife with a five to six inch blade and punched and stabbed the woman several times in the stomach. He dropped the knife and Mr Keig tried to kick it away. As he did so the man picked it up and stabbed him in the left thigh. Mr Keig was later treated at hospital.

By his actions Mr Keig displayed commendable courage.
