On the afternoon of 10 January 2011, several members of the Queensland Fire and Rescue Service Swift Water Rescue team deployed to the vicinity of Murphy's Creek following major flooding that inundated the Lockyer Valley. They deployed as teams and conducted search and rescue operations for missing and trapped people as they negotiated the floodwater. During operations, several members narrowly escaped being engulfed by floodwaters as they drove across a bridge which was hit by a wall of water and debris several metres high which crashed into it before they were able to reverse off the bridge. During separate incidents, other team members nearly drowned or were swept away. In horrendous conditions and in darkness, they searched damaged houses, properties, vehicles, waterways and creeks where they located and rescued men, women and children, some of whom had been stripped of their clothing by the force of the water. Using swift water rescue techniques they conducted rescues on foot, wading through waist high mud and water, and by inflatable rescue boat. The team also located deceased persons and advised the police. As they continued to sweep the area, they also released many animals and livestock who were trapped in flooded paddocks. The team performed numerous rescues in the Murphy's Creek, Grantham and Leichhardt areas until early on 12 January 2011.

On the afternoon of 10 January 2011, the flight crew of Helitak 220 responded as part the Queensland Fire and Rescue Service (QFRS) response during the Queensland flood events in the Lockyer Valley. Assisted by the helicopter Firebird 460 to locate trapped persons, over two days they conducted rescue operations in strong gusting winds, torrential rain and poor visibility. After identifying several buildings in the floodwaters with people inside or on the roof, the crew performed rescues using winch rescue techniques. At Grantham, Helitak 220 went to a two story house surrounded by water in the middle of the flood stream. They rescued a man and teenage boy in separate sorties, before they were relocated to safety. Also at Grantham, when a family of three was swept into the water from atop their submerged vehicle. Helitak 220 transported a woman, who was rescued by QFRS personnel onto an island, to the nearby highway. When they searched the area further they found her son downstream on a hay bailer, surrounded by swift flowing water. Using a two person winch they rescued the boy, who was in shock and bleeding profusely on his legs, and reunited him with his mother. Ten minutes later, Helitak 220 responded to a call that a house had been swept 300 metres downstream containing an elderly couple in chest deep water. The rescue crewman was lowered into the water upstream from the house. When he made his way into the house, he secured the woman where they were pulled clear and into the helicopter. He then re-entered the house and rescued the man and family dog. They were then transported to a nearby field and into the care of swift water technicians. Throughout the two days of operations, the two helicopter crews conducted 47 rescues, including one rescue where 12 people were evacuated from a roof top by hover emplane.

On the evening of 10 January 2011, thirteen members of the Police Public Safety Response Team were deployed to assist with the significant flooding event in the Lockyer Valley. In darkness, and in major storm conditions, they negotiated damaged bridges and flooded roads, where they encountered large piles of debris, downed trees and powerlines. As they approached Grantham, they were held back by a vast expanse of high flood water. Assisted by a council driver with a front end loader, some of the officers climbed into the bucket while others held onto the outside of the vehicle as it was driven into the water. They got out of the loader to search damaged houses and submerged vehicles for any missing or trapped people. After the officers completed their search of Grantham, at about 5:00am on 11 January, they redeployed to Murphy's Creek and later to Postman's Ridge where they continued to search for people along creeks and rivers. Despite a severe weather warning that further major flash flooding was likely, the officers continued their operations and located several people. At Postman's Ridge, the officers conducted door-to-door checks and advised the community about the latest severe weather warning. The team worked continuously for 24 hours.

In the early hours on 30 December 2010, following several days of rain the Burnett River experienced major flooding at Bundaberg. The owners of a catamaran were attempting to evacuate when a large tree floated under the vessel and took hold of the anchor and chain. They were unable to manoeuvre their vessel as it travelled backwards in the strong current. When the stricken vessel passed Paddy's Island, two men motored a 5hp dinghy into the swift current to reach it. When one of the men boarded the vessel the other man used the dinghy to push and steer the catamaran from side to side to avoid it hitting other boats. When anchor equipment from the rescue dinghy failed, the owner of the catamaran was forced to cut its anchor chain free from the attached tree. After gaining control, the vessel was able to set another anchor about 40 seconds prior to reaching the dangerous Ferry Crossing area. Prior to this, during daylight hours, the two men had taken rescue boats along the swollen river where many vessels had broken loose of their moorings. They re-anchored to them to stop them from rushing down the river.

On the evening of 10 January 2011, the Police Specialist Emergency Response Team was deployed to Grantham, where the majority of the township was inundated by floodwaters; houses were ripped from their footings and people swept away. Over several hours, the Response Group operated in areas that had large amounts of debris which included vehicles, houses, sheds and downed power lines. The team split into two groups, with one group using a front-end loader to assist with rescue operations. On the night of 10 January 2011, as a Police Special Emergency Response Team (SERT) attempted to deploy to Grantham following a flash flood, they saw quarry workers operating a 40-tonne front-end loader moving debris off the road to allow expected rescue workers through. The quarry workers worked with the SERT team to facilitate immediate rescue operations for people trapped in severely damaged houses, driving the loader across a road and bridge that was under water. They then positioned rescued people in the bucket, with the SERT officers standing on the lip of the bucket while it was moving to ensure that people remained secure. More than 60 people were rescued using this mode. The loader team went to a house where up to twenty people were trapped on a roof that was in danger of collapse, removing the people and pets through the flowing water to safety. As the water level rose, the men retreated to Helidon and rescued two more families in isolated houses using their loader. Following a short period of rest, they returned to Grantham and used their quarry equipment to support the recovery effort for several weeks.

Between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January 2011, members of the Training Ship (TS) Ipswich Naval Cadet Unit volunteered as boat crews in support of police rescue operations for the Queensland flood emergency. On the evening of 3 May 2009, a vehicle carrying four passengers was overtaking a semi-trailer on the Maroondah Highway at Merton when the driver lost control, spinning into the path of an oncoming vehicle. Upon impact, the first vehicle spun and stopped on the roadway, whilst the second vehicle, carrying five passengers, left the road and rolled before landing on its roof.
