TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS it is desirable that there be instituted an Australian medal for the purpose of according recognition to civilians who rendered certain service during World War II:

KNOW YOU that We do by these Presents institute a medal to be called the Civilian Service Medal 1939–1945:

AND WE DO ordain that the award of the Civilian Service Medal 1939–1945 is governed by the Regulations set out in the Schedule.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
