AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD
OF THE CIVILIAN SERVICE MEDAL 1939-1945

1. Regulation 6 is amended by inserting after subregulation 6 (1) the following subregulation:

“(1A) For the purposes of subregulation (1), the Minister may deem a person to have served for the qualifying period required by that subregulation if the person’s service:

- (a) was terminated, because of death, disability or illness of the person due to that service, before the qualifying period was completed; and
- (b) in the opinion of the Minister, the person would have completed the qualifying period within the war period, but for that termination.”.

2. Regulation 7 is revoked and the following regulation substituted:

Delegation of powers

“7. The Minister may delegate to a Senior Executive Service Officer in the Department:

- (a) the power under subregulation 6 (1) to recommend the award of the Medal; and
- (b) the power under subregulation 6 (1A) to deem a person to have served for the qualifying period required by subregulation 6 (1).”.
