ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth:

TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS it is desirable that there be instituted a medal for the purpose of according recognition to members of Australian police forces and certain other persons who render service in international peacekeeping operations:

KNOW YOU that We do by these Presents institute an Australian medal to be designated and styled the Police Overseas Service Medal:

AND WE DO ordain that the award of the Police Overseas Service Medal shall be governed by the Regulations set out in the Schedule.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
