### Amendments of the Police Overseas Service Medal Regulations 2007

**[1] Regulation 3**

**3 Declaration of prescribed service**

- (1) The Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Minister, may declare a period of overseas service to be prescribed service for the purposes of these Regulations if:
  - (a) the service was undertaken by members of an Australian police force; and
  - (b) the service was for the purpose of peacekeeping or capacity building; and
  - (c) the service was undertaken:
    - (i) as part of an international operation; or
    - (ii) following a request for assistance by a foreign government.
- (2) The Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Minister, may declare a period of service to be prescribed service for the purposes of these Regulations if the service was undertaken:
  - (a) by members of the Royal Papua New Guinea Constabulary; and
  - (b) as patrol officers.
