4 (1A) In this Regulation —

relevant Antarctic expedition means an Antarctic expedition that:

- (a) is an Australian Antarctic expedition; or
- (b) includes an individual who represents an Australian government agency or an Australian institution.
- (1) The Medal may be awarded to an individual who has given outstanding service in scientific research or exploration, or in support of such work, in relation to a relevant Antarctic expedition.
