# Iraq Medal Regulations 2004

## 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Iraq Medal Regulations 2004.

### 2 Definitions

In these Regulations:

**Defence Force** means the Defence Force constituted under the *Defence Act 1903*.

*Medal* means the Iraq Medal instituted under the Letters Patent establishing these Regulations.

*Minister* means the Minister of State for Defence or the Minister Assisting the Minister of State for Defence.

operational area of Iraq means the area determined by the Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Minister, for the purposes of this definition.

*prescribed operation* means an operation declared to be a prescribed operation under regulation 3.

**Register** means the Register maintained under subregulation 10 (2).

**Registrar** means the Registrar of Awards appointed under subregulation 10 (1).

## 3 Declaration of prescribed operations

The Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Minister, may declare an operation in Iraq, including a support operation in the surrounding areas, in which members of the Defence Force are engaged or have been engaged on or after

18 March 2003, to be a prescribed operation for the purposes of these Regulations.

## 4 Design of Medal

The design of the Medal is as determined by the Governor-General.

## 5 Conditions for award of Medal

- (1) The Medal may be awarded for service in the operational area of Iraq in connection with a prescribed operation.
- (2) The persons to whom the Medal may be awarded are:
  - (a) persons who served in a prescribed operation as members of the Defence Force; and
  - (b) persons included in a class of persons determined by the Minister for the purposes of this regulation.
- (3) The other conditions for the award of the Medal are the conditions determined by the Governor-General on the recommendation of the Minister.
- (4) The Medal may only be awarded to a person who fulfils the conditions for the award of the Medal.

## 6 Making of awards

Awards of the Medal shall be made by the Governor-General on the recommendation of the Chief of the Defence Force or his or her delegate.

## 7 Cancellation of award

- (1) On the recommendation of the Chief of the Defence Force or his or her delegate, the Governor-General may cancel an award of the Medal.
- (2) If an award of the Medal is cancelled:
  - (a) the Registrar must note the cancellation in the Register; and

(b) the person holding the Medal must return the Medal to the Registrar.

### 8 Reinstatement of award

- (1) On the recommendation of the Chief of the Defence Force or his or her delegate, the Governor-General may reinstate an award that has been cancelled under regulation 7.
- (2) If an award is reinstated, the Registrar must:
  - (a) note the reinstatement in the Register; and
  - (b) return the Medal to the person to whom it was awarded.

## 9 Wearing of Medal

The manner of wearing the Medal is as determined by the Governor-General.

## 10 Registrar of Awards

- (1) The Governor-General must appoint a Registrar of Awards.
- (2) The Registrar must maintain:
  - (a) a Register containing the name of each person to whom the Medal has been awarded; and
  - (b) such other records, relating to the Medal, as the Governor-General directs.
