WHEREAS it is desirable that there be instituted an Australian medal for the purpose of according recognition to persons who render outstanding public service:

KNOW YOU that We do by these Presents institute a medal to be designated and styled the Public Service Medal:

AND WE DO ordain that the award of the medal so instituted shall be governed by the Regulations Governing the Award of the Public Service Medal set out in the Schedule.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
