




Australian Operational Service Medal (Greater Middle East Operation) Instrument Amendment 2022

1 Name

This instrument is the *Australian Operational Service Medal (Greater Middle East Operation) Instrument Amendment 2022*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after signature.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 3(1) and subsection 4(3A) of the *Australian Operational Service Medal Regulation 2012*.

4 Amendment

This instrument amends the *Australian Operational Service Medal (Greater Middle East Operation) Instrument 2015* made on 13 April 2015.

5 Paragraph 6(d) (Declared operations)

After paragraph 6(d), insert:

- (e) Operation AUGURY, that:
 - (i) commenced on 4 July 2014 within the area comprising the land, internal waters, territorial seas and superjacent airspace of Jordan;
 - (ii) commenced 28 April 2016 within the area comprising the land, internal waters, territorial seas and superjacent airspace of the United Arab Emirates and Jordan;
 - (ii) commenced on 28 April 2016 within the area comprising the land and superjacent airspace of Afghanistan;
 - (iv) commenced on 1 December 2020 within the area comprising the land, internal waters, territorial seas and superjacent airspace of Iraq and Syria.

6 Section 8 (Conditions)

Omit “paragraph 4(3)(b), substitute “subsection 4(3A)”.

7 Section 9 (Eligible service – additional period of qualifying service)

Omit twice occurring “section 6 of this instrument”, substitute “section 7 of this instrument”.
