On 2 September 2008 Trooper S demonstrated conspicuous gallantry by knowingly and selflessly exposing himself to sustained effective enemy fire in order to protect a severely wounded Australian soldier. In doing so he almost certainly prevented the wounded soldier sustaining further injuries and ultimately saved his life.
